Heyde retired from WSO in November of 2022 after 35 years of music directing and conducting. Heyde was awarded with the Music Director Emeritus title, and he served as the second conductor of WSO.

WSO received more than 100 applications from people all over the globe who were seeking to be the next Music Director. WSO's 11-member search committee performed extensive review of these applicants.

Each of the four finalists, Loh and three others, guest conducted a WSO classical concert and visited Waco for a week to meet Board and community members.

During WSO's October 2023 "Breaking Boundaries" performance, Loh led the symphony in a performance that included Shostakovich's Symphony No. 5. This symphony is groundbreaking in its breadth, technical challenge and emotional scope. Loh described this piece as music that transports the listener out of the world in which they are in, as it translates a message that words cannot articulate.

Loh is the Music Director of The Syracuse Orchestra (formerly Symphoria) in Syracuse, New York. Over his career he has held various other conducting positions with the Syracuse Opera, Dallas Symphony Orchestra, Pittsburgh Symphony and Pittsburgh Youth Symphony, Northeastern Pennsylvania Philharmonic, West Virginia Symphony Orchestra, and the Colorado Symphony.

Loh has been a frequent guest conductor of orchestras all over the world. A highlight of his career was working directly with film composer legend John Williams. In addition to working with guest soloists like Itzhak Perlman, James Ehnes, and Garrick Ohlsson, Loh has also worked with Broadway and pop artists like Idina Menzel and Chris Botti. He has conducted a variety of Films in Concert, most recently "Black Panther," "The Princess Bride" "The Nightmare Before Christmas," and various "Star Wars" films.
